## **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### 1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

#### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all dinghies with a Portsmouth Yardstick.
  - Multihulls are not permitted.
- 2.2 Boats may enter by posting an entry form, by 25th April 2014, together with the required fee, to the address given below, in Further Information
- 2.3 Boats may enter online. The last date for online entry is Thursday 1st May.
- 2.4 Boats may enter at the event providing the entry limit has not been reached.
- 2.5 Entry is limited to a maximum of 100 boats.

#### 3 FEES

3.1 Required fees are as follows:

Туре	Weekend Cost	Daily Cost
Double Hander	£40	£15
Single Hander	£30	£12.

The entry fee includes social events for competitors on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Additional social event tickets may be purchased at registration.

#### 4 RACE SERIES

4.1 Racing fleets will include, as a minimum, the following:

Fleet	PY Range
Fast Handicap	1009 and below
Medium Handicap	1010 and above

Depending on entries, the PY ranges may be adjusted and/or additional fleets may be added. There will be class racing for fleets of sufficient numbers

4.2 The regatta will consist of a five race series.

There will be two races on Saturday, two races on Sunday and one race on Monday.

#### 5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration will take place at the Tudor Sailing Club on Friday evening from 1900 until 2200 and on Saturday morning from 1000 until 1230.
- 5.2 The scheduled times of the first warning signal each day are as follows:

#### **6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

6.1 Sailing instructions will be available at registration and on the website.

#### 7 VENUE

7.1 Racing will take place in Langstone Harbour.

#### 8 RULES DISPUTES PROCEDURE

8.1 The Exoneration Penalty and the Advisory Hearing and RYA Arbitration of the RYA Rules Disputes Procedures will be available.

#### 9 SCORING

- 9.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.
- 9.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.3 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst scores as follows:

Races sailed	1	2	3	4	5
Scores excluded	0	0	1	1	2

#### 10 BERTHING

10.1 Visiting dinghies may be stored at the Tudor Sailing Club.

#### 11 PRIZES

- 11.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats in each fleet for the series.
- 11.2 There will be a daily prize for the winner of the each fleet. On days when there is more than one race, both races are to count.
- 11.3 If there are sufficient boats of a one-design class racing in a handicap fleet, their results will be removed from the handicap fleet and scored as a separate fleet. They will receive their own prizes.

#### 12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### 13 INSURANCE

13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
