Notice of Race Regatta 2015

Saturday 27th June 2015Start time 13.00Sunday 28th June 2015Start time 11.00

This will be a Scottish Traveller event for the following classes : Enterprise, 2000, Solo, Laser and Scottish Skiffs class Plus open Handicap class

1 Rules

The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 Advertising

Advertising will be restricted to Category A

3 Eligibility and Entry

- a) The event is open to all. We do encourage as many participants to pre-enter using the link here to the entry form which you can complete and forward on to us.
- b) Eligible boats may enter on the day by completing an entry form in the Clubhouse and paying the required fee.

4 Fees

Entry fees are as follows:

Double hander's £25

Single hander's £15

Barbecue tickets can be purchased at entry, this will follow on straight after sailing/early evening to be held on the Patio. Please BYOB

5 Schedule

- a) Registration will be open from 09.00hrs on Saturday.
- b) There will be a briefing 1hr before the first start time of the day.
- c) Racing will take place in Largo Bay with the first race to start at 13.00.
- d) There will be three races for all classes back to back on each day.

6 Measurements

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate on request of the Race Committee.

7 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available on registration.

8 Courses

The courses to be sailed will be as depicted in the sailing instructions.

9 Scoring

- 9.1 The scoring system will be the RYA Low Points System per Appendix A.
- 9.2 4 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.3 When more than 4 races are completed there will be one discard allowed for calculation of the yachts series score

10 Prize giving

Prize giving will be held as soon as possible after racing on Sunday.

11 Camping

For tent pitching we have a number of gardens in the village please ask at registration.

12 Risk Statement

Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

(a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such Inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;

(b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;

(c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;

(d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;

(e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;

13 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
