South West Series

Notice of Race 2017

The South West Series is made up of three pursuit races where the best sailors compete against their fellow sailors and the worst of the British weather to find the best sailor in the South West.

The competitor with the lowest aggregate sore from the Starcross Steamer, Roadford Rocket and the Wimbleball Beastie will be crowned the winner 2017.

The Organising Authority for the series is the combined clubs of Starcross YC, Roadford SC and Wimbleball SC.

Rules

The International Federation's Racing Rules of Sailing (2017-2020) and this Notice of Race, unless amended by the Sailing Instructions will govern the racing.

Any conflict between the South West Series Notice of Race and the Notice of Race of each individual club, then the Notice of Race of the club shall prevail.

Entries

By entering any of the three events the competitor is automatically entered into the South West Series, without further payment.

The Events

Starcross Steamer on Sunday February 5th 2017 Roadford Rocket on Sunday February 26th 2017 Wimbleball Beastie on Sunday March 19th 2017

Eligibility

Each club has its own limitations to classes allowed to race, please refer to the club NOR. It is the competitor's responsibility to enter and pay for each event. Note: some events may be limited to a maximum number, so early entry is advised.

Prizes

The overall prize for the Senior event (18 years and over) and the Junior (under 18 on the day of the last event) will be awarded when the first of the following conditions are fulfilled. Should one or more events be cancelled and not re-sailed at a later date then only the results from the sailed events will be counted. In the event of a tie then the result of the last race shall take precedence.

- 1. A helm and crew (double hander) or helm (single hander) that has completed all the races with the same boat and rig.
- 2. A helm and crew (double hander) or helm (single hander) that has completed all the races.
- 3. A helm and different crew who have completed all the races.

Scoring

Scoring will be on a 'low points' scoring system (1 point for first, 4 for 4th etc.). Boats scoring a DNF, OCD, RET or DSQ will be given a score equal to the number of boats entered in the race plus one. Boat with DNE or DNS will not be given a score so will not be eligible for the overall prize. The prizes will be presented during the prize giving at the last event of the series
